Brazoria County Library Report

A motion was made to approve funds for the book supports for holds in the amount of \$304.42 including shipping. This motion was approved.

Magazine covers for 35 magazines in the amount of \$633.33 was also approved. The covers are \$15.39 each.

Money for the art work for the walls was also approved. Two checks from the friends group were cut in the total amount of \$2,158.00.

Signs and bookends have been ordered.

The library is waiting on approval from the property manager for the miniblinds.

Stephen has not yet given a dollar amount for the dvd or blu ray players.

A self-checkout machine is being purchased for \$7651.00 by the county.

The library lease does not allow public events in the library unless they are library sponsored events.

The County wide booksale will be on July 25, 26 and 27th at the Angleton Library
There will be an event at the Brazoria County Fairgrounds featuring Mickey Gilley and JD Davis on August 29th. Tickets are \$40.00. The doors open at 6 PM and dinner will be at 6:30 PM

The legislative session approved \$7.5 million for texshare and reinstating the k-12 databases. There was also money approved for the Sam Houston Center in Liberty, TX. They are still working on the Federal government waiver.

Our water bill and utilities have a check off donation to the library.

A law was passed to allow the library to sue for lost library books.

The meeting was adjourned at 8:40 PM.
